“How to Revitalize the Japanese and Asian Economies ?”

During the recent years, the possibility of a decoupling of the Asian economies from the US and European economies has been often debated. The most recent months have witnessed a dramatic decline of the economic activity in Japan, while the magnitude and nature of the slowdown in China is still debated. In such circumstances, we are delighted to benefit from the views of Professor Yoshino (Keio University) who has played an important role in the regulatory reforms in Japanese financial services and is following closely the evolution of the current situation.

Naoyuki Yoshino is a Professor of Economics at Keio University since 1991. His professional career includes membership at numerous government committees. Since 2004, he has been a Director of Financial Research and Training Center at Japan's Financial Services Agency (FSA). He was appointed as a Board Chair of Financial Planning Standard Board in 2007. He also chairs several Councils of the Ministry of Finance (Foreign Exchange Council, Fiscal Council (reform of Government banking system) Privatization of government-owned enterprises). He is also a Board Member of Japan's Deposit Insurance Corporation and of the Financial Council of the Government of Japan. His most recent publications includes “Postal Savings and Fiscal Investment in Japan” (Oxford University Press, with T. Cargill) “Small Savings Mobilization and Asian Economic Development” (with M.E. Sharpe and M.J. Scher).
